



## Wakefield East Nomination Group



### **WAKEFIELD EAST NOMINATION GROUP**

<b>ALLOCATION BACKGROUND</b>	On July 9, 2009, Northern posted a Marquette Branchline force majeure for the 2009-2010 heating season. On October 30, 2009 Northern posted a notice that it was establishing a Wakefield East allocation methodology. Successfully scheduling volumes for delivery east of Wakefield, MI is based on proportional volume of receipts being scheduled at the Wakefield GLGT Interconnect (POI 21972). If insufficient volumes are nominated at the Wakefield Interconnect to support the nominated load on the Marquette branch line, Northern will be required to perform an allocation on those downstream deliveries. Northern has established a Wakefield East Nomination Group (Group 789) to address such situations.
<b>ALLOCATION CRITERIA</b>	Nominations sourced from receipt points upstream of the Wakefield GLGT Interconnect (POI 21972) for delivery downstream of the Wakefield GLGT Interconnect (POI 21972) along Northern's pipeline east to the end of the Marquette Branchline exceeding the capacity of the Wakefield East Nomination Group.
<b>ALLOCATION GROUP CAPACITY</b>	60,000 Dth
<b>ALLOCATION SPECIFIC DETAILS</b>	<p>Shippers nominating at a zone level will be presumed to have nominated pro-rata based on the entitlement at the affected Zone EF delivery points listed in the link provided below. The pro-rata share will be calculated by the percentage of the Firm MDQ contracted at each of the identified Zone EF delivery points relative to the Shipper's total contracted firm MDQ at Zone EF. When Shippers nominate directly at any of the points listed below rather than at the zone level, the nominated quantity at the point will be included in the allocation. The group capacity will be allocated based on the following priority of service:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. First off (lowest priority) – Interruptible nominations are allocated by price</li> <li>2. Next off – Alternate Firm Delivery Point sourced from Alternate Firm Receipt Point (allocated pro rata)</li> <li>3. Next off – Alternate Firm Delivery point sourced from a Primary Firm Receipt Point and Primary Firm Delivery point sourced from an Alternate Firm Receipt Point (allocated pro rata).</li> <li>4. Primary Firm Delivery point sourced from Primary Firm Receipt without the requested receipts at Wakefield (allocated pro rata).</li> <li>5. Primary Firm Delivery point sourced from Primary Firm Receipt with the requested receipts at Wakefield (allocated pro rata).</li> </ol>

**SPECIFIC RECEIPT POINTS NOT IMPACTED**

Nominations from the following receipt points to Zone EF delivery points, may not be impacted by the Wakefield East allocation because they are unaffected by the constraint. ***However, please note that NONE of these receipt points can be used when "truing-up" daily increase takes on ANY of the allocated delivery points during the Final Cycle. As a reminder, per the 8:00 AM Non-Grid Final Nomination Process Guidelines, NO increases to physical allocated points can be made.***
