Dear Ms. Reese:

In accordance with Condition 5 of the Order Issuing Certificate and Approving Abandonment issued February 19, 2025, by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), Northern Natural Gas (Northern) hereby submits for filing in the above-referenced docket a request for approval to utilize two additional extra temporary workspace (ETWS) on the Lake Mills to Albert Lea E-line extension (Lake Mills extension).

Specifically, Northern is requesting approval to utilize ETWS18 and ETWS19, which are more fully described in the following table.

The proposed ETWS is being requested to accommodate the placement of topsoil and subsoil during open-cut trenching. Soil in the area is very saturated with several feet of standing water accumulating in low spots on the right of way. The soils exceed the liquid limit preventing cohesion of the soil particles necessary to pile the spoils as high as normal. This additional workspace is needed to allow for the wider soil storage piles.

The proposed ETWS is located within the environmentally cleared area and no additional agency consultation is required. The surrounding land use is agricultural and no sensitive

resources will be impacted. Northern received written landowner approval to use the proposed ETWS on August 14, 2025, and August 19, 2025, for Tract FR007 and Tract FR010, respectively.

The attached alignment sheets (public and privileged version) depict the proposed ETWS, which is highlighted with a Delta F3 symbol. The privileged alignment sheets contain confidential information regarding landowner names and have therefore been labeled "CUI//PRIV ---DO NOT RELEASE (PRIVILEGED)." Pursuant to 18 CFR Section 388.112, Northern requests confidential and privileged treatment of the privileged alignment sheets due to the confidential nature of the contents.
