Northern Responses to Landowner Comments

Dear Ms. Reese:

Northern Natural Gas Company (Northern) submits for filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) in the above-referenced docket Northern's responses to comments filed with FERC by affected landowners regarding the proposed projects. Specifically, Northern is providing responses to the comments filed by Natalia Arndt; the Wenzel Family Trust / Tim and Janice Wenzel; and Brandon Murray, son of the landowner.

- Natalia Arndt filed a motion to intervene with comments March 19, 2026; Northern reached out to the landowner to acknowledge their concerns. Northern confirmed it is committed to ongoing communication and coordination and to working with the landowner in good faith as the project moves forward. The landowner expressed appreciation for the timely outreach and indicated a willingness to work with Northern.
- Brandon Murray, son of the landowner, filed comments March 30, 2026; Northern met with the landowner and the parties reached a resolution on the outstanding issues. The landowner's son agreed to submit a follow-up filing to FERC confirming the prior comments have been resolved and that there are no additional concerns.
- Wenzel Family Trust / Tim and Janice Wenzel filed a motion to intervene with comments April 6, 2026; Northern contacted the landowner, who expressed limited concerns related to the proposed project. He inquired generally about compensation, at which time right of way provided a high-level overview of the compensation framework, including an explanation of potential crop damages. After an extended discussion concerning prior projects and associated concerns, the landowner indicated that his primary interest is ensuring receipt of all required notices from FERC. No additional concerns were identified.
