Pursuant to Rule 214(d) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (‘FERC’ or ‘Commission’), 18 C.F.R. Â§ 385.214(d), Minnesota Energy Resources Corporation (‘MERC’), Upper Michigan Energy Resources Corporation (‘UMERC’), Wisconsin Electric Power Company (‘Wisconsin Electric’) and Wisconsin Gas Company LLC (‘Wisconsin Gas’) (‘WEC Companies’) hereby move to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding.
