Carlton Resolution

- At the July 16, 2020 meeting, it was suggested that Northern consider the applicability of the Carlton Penalty during times when Northern is required to allocate Carlton receipts due to excess nominations. Northern currently does not have the authority to waive the Carlton Penalty.

Proposal: Northern proposes to file a modification to the tariff to permit Northern the right to waive such penalty in a not unduly discriminatory manner.

- Open discussion regarding additional customer feedback regarding any proposed modifications to the Carlton flow obligation as discussed in the previous meeting.

Management of DDVC and SMS

- Although Northern does not have a specific proposal at this time, based on customer feedback, Northern will focus ongoing discussions on two main areas:
